

Monthly premium (2008 Medicare Costs)

Part A (Hospital Insurance) Monthly Premium

Most people don't pay Part A premium because they paid Medicare taxes while working. You pay up to \$423 each month if you don't get premium-free Part A.*

Part B (Medical Insurance) Monthly Premium

(As required by the Medicare Modernization Act of 2003, and beginning in 2007)
